It was during his surgical training that Dr. Graham developed a strong interest in facial growth and orthodontics. This interest took Dr. Graham to Rochester, New York, where he received his certificate in orthodontics from the University of Rochester/Eastman Dental Center.

Dr. Graham is one of only a few orthodontists in the U.S. who is also a licensed physician. He has extensive experience with temporary skeletal anchorage and its many orthodontic applications. He has authored multiple journal articles and book chapters on the subject and lectures extensively around the world. His unique medical and surgical background help contribute to his ability to understand craniofacial growth, facial esthetics, jaw surgery and all other aspects of orthodontics.
